

China's DCD Produces First Diesel Engine Under Navistar Licensing Pact

Advanced NGD3.0E turbodiesel to power SUVs, pickup trucks, and light commercial vehicles in China

CHAOYANG, LIAONING PROVINCE, China — Dongfeng Chaoyang Diesel Engine Co. Ltd. (DCD), one of China's largest diesel engine makers, today began full-scale production of an advanced 3.0-liter automotive diesel engine licensed from an affiliate of MWM INTERNATIONAL Industria de Motores da America do Sul Ltda., a Brazilian affiliate of Navistar International Corporation.

The in-line four-cylinder turbocharged design features a piezo-injector common-rail fuel system that provides fuel-efficient, low-emissions diesel performance. The engine, manufactured at DCD's Chaoyang plant, will power SUVs, pickups and light commercial vehicles. Initial estimated annual volumes are projected to be 40,000 to 50,000 engines per year.

"Today's start-up is Job 1 in our long-term commitment not only to our working relationship with DCD but to the China automotive market," said Waldey Sanchez, president and CEO of São Paulo, Brazil-based MWM INTERNATIONAL (MWMI). "We're honored to work with DCD to collaboratively offer the most advanced diesel technologies for low-cost, clean-burning, on-road vehicle operation."

MWMI and its affiliate, and DCD are looking for opportunities to cooperate in the areas of engine development and vehicle application for diesel engines in Chinese manufactured vehicles. This type of cooperation may be extended to other engine families and other countries in the region.

The NGD 3.0E turbodiesel provides 140–185 horsepower [104–138 kW of power] and 340–440 N. m of torque.

"With engine performance and environmental needs continuing to advance, this new engine provides our customers with a new level of technology. Our relationship with MWM International ensures that we'll offer the best diesel power for future needs as well."
