In addition, Iveco will continue to build and sell its existing ADR80-02 inventory of International trucks, which is currently estimated to extend through approximately June 2011. Existing product warranties for vehicles sold through this time will continue in force as per their original terms.

"Iveco is pleased to continue its relationship with Navistar as an authorized provider of parts, service and support for International trucks, for the long term," said Giorgio Gallia, Iveco's Managing Director. "Current International truck buyers can be assured of receiving excellent ongoing support for the current range of International trucks produced in Australia."

"This amicable agreement preserves continued service for International brand trucks in Australia," said Phil Christman, president, Navistar global truck operations. "We look forward to continuing to provide our Australian customers with new truck models via the dealer network being established by NC2."
